**General**

**How many applications did your office receive in the last round of funding, and of those how many were awarded.**

There were 24 applications for the VEAP 2009/10 Solicitation for Proposals (SFP) and of those 15 were funded. Please visit the [EDD Web site](#) for a list of awardees and project summaries.

### **Allowable Activities**

**1. Can training dollars be used for soft skills training that could include financial literacy, basic skills, contextual workplace literacy and conflict resolution?**

Yes, WIA 15 percent funds can be used to provide soft skills training you identified above in order to prepare individuals for unsubsidized employment or training.

**2. Can a participant be enrolled in training that exceeds 12 months?**

Yes, training can exceed 12 months.

**3. Can agencies awarded the grant use training providers who are not on the ETPL or I-TRAIN lists?**

It is not a requirement of this SFP that training providers be on either the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) or Intrastate Training Resource and Information Network (I-TRAIN).

**Match**

**Can WIA funded services be used as leveraged dollars for the required match?**

As stated on page 9 of the SFP, match may include WIA and non-WIA funds made available to the applicant to be used specifically for this proposal's activities. All cash/in-kind match must be documented with a letter of commitment verifying the match amount.
