SUBJECT: GOVERNOR'S CALGRIP 2009/10 SFP AWARDS—WIA FUNDS

On May 11, 2010, the Employment Development Department, in coordination with the California Workforce Investment Board and the Labor and Workforce Development Agency, announced the availability of at least \$6 million in Workforce Investment Act Governor's Discretionary 15 Percent funds through the Governor's Gang Reduction Intervention and Prevention Initiative (CalGRIP) Solicitation for Proposals (SFP). The purpose of the SFP is to expand job training for youth that are at-risk of gang involvement, gang involved or current gang members.

In a Press Release dated June 30, 2010, Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger announced grant awards totaling \$7.5 million to 16 organizations through the SFP process.
