SUBJECT: JTA SYSTEM VERSION 4.51.0 RELEASE

The purpose of this Information Notice is to inform the Workforce Development Community that the Workforce Services Division (WSD) will release Job Training Automation (JTA) System modification Version 4.51.0 on the weekend of July 10, 2010, and the system software will be available beginning Monday, July 12, 2010.

The following provides a description of various programming changes implemented in this release that affects the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) and American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) program.

WIA SYSTEM – JTA Programs Modified

EWIE – Enter WIA Enrollment Form (Log #6544)

LWIA – Load WIA Activity Data

A programming modification was made to the EWIE and LWIA programs to remove the edit check that required the Document of Eligibility (EDOE) Form to be completed as it relates to registration and enrollment activities. This change impacts integrated Learning Lab (LL) offices. Effective June 23, 2010, a system patch was added to the system resulting in an early deployment of this change.

EWIT – Enter WIA Exit Form (Log #6542)

LWIT – Load WIA Exit Form

A programming change was made to the EWIT and LWIT programs to remove the restriction on LL offices that prevented access to the exit form. This modification allows LL offices to access exit forms to manually enter data including exit dates. The soft exit program is in place and will continue to automatically close LL office records after 90 days when inactivity is identified.

PARAL – Print Local WIA ARRA (Adult, DW, NEG) Monthly Participant Report
XARAL – Extract Local WIA ARRA (Adult, DW, NEG) Monthly Participant Report
(Log #6541)

The purpose of the PARAL program is to calculate, retrieve, and print and/or view Local ARRA Adult, DW, and NEG WIA Monthly Participant Reports. XARAL is called to run when PARAL is initiated and stores the specific report data. This program adds to the PARAL (XARAL modified respectively) option screen the choice to calculate ARRA only grant groups (Adult /02, Adult 15%/06, DW/14, DW 15%/07) and store the data using an ARRA only indicator (arra_only_indctr).

PARYL – Print Local WIA ARRA Youth Monthly Participant Report
XARYL – Extract Local WIA ARRA Youth Monthly Participant Report
(Log#6552)

The purpose of the PARYL program is to calculate, retrieve, and print and/or view Local WIA ARRA Youth Monthly Participant Reports. XARYL is called to run when PARYL is initiated and stores the specific report data. The programming change to PARYL and XARYL modifies Field A.11 - Number of Participants Placed into Summer Employment, Field B.1 - Summer Work Readiness, and Field B.3 - Completion Rate to split and display the data into two categories: (a) 2009 Summer, and (b) 2010 Summer.

PSAF – Print WIA Short Application Form (Log #6555)

The purpose of this program is to add the capability to print the WIA Short Application Form with a signature block similar to the existing Print WIA Registration Form (PWIA) program.

PWIL – Print WIA Listing (Log #6538)

The purpose of this change is to add logic to the programming to retrieve and print a listing of WIA registrants that are participating under Eligibility Code "L". This code represents the 5 Percent Window of ARRA Youth (age 14-24) where 5 percent of ARRA/WIA registrants are enrolled for services, but do not meet the low-income eligibility requirement to receive services.

LDOE – Load Document of Eligibility (Log #6545)

The purpose of the LDOE program is to load flat (ascii) files into the JTA Document of Eligibility table (doc_eligy) in the local database. The programming modification changes the edit check to make the social security number (wia_ssn), application number (wia_app_num) and resume flag (resume_flg; still allows Option 2 LL to load data) fields required. All other fields on the form have been modified to be optional.

XWID – Extract WIA Data (Log #6557)

The XWID program is used to extract WIA participant data and create a compatible file for transferring local data to the Stateside database. A programming change was made to add an edit check to require that at least one youth test record exist when an exit record is entered even if it has been < 90 days from enrollment.

LWID – Load WIA Data (6558)

The LWID program is used to load participant data to the applicable tables in the stateside database. The program typically deletes existing data records and generates new records with incoming data. The LWID was modified to save and store the old records. If load errors occur during the latest load process, prior records can be retrieved to restore the tables with prior participant records.
