SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA LOW COST AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PROGRAM

The purpose of this Information Notice is to share information regarding the California Low Cost Automobile Insurance Program sponsored by the California Department of Insurance.

The California Low Cost Automobile Insurance Program satisfies the State law that all drivers must have automobile insurance. The California Low Cost Auto Insurance Program provides eligible drivers automobile liability insurance for less than \$400 per year. Applicants may qualify for this program if they:

- Are at least 19 years of age
- Have been licensed to drive for at least 3 consecutive years
- Own a vehicle that is valued at \$20,000 or less
- Meet income eligibility requirements
- Are in a household of 1-8 persons

Income eligibility for the program can be established based on unemployment benefit information, current paycheck stubs, or previous year income tax returns.

One Stop Career Centers are encouraged to provide information to individuals that may benefit from this Low Cost Automobile Insurance Program. Some options for providing information are as follows:

- Invite the California Department of Insurance to meet with your One-Stop personnel.
- Request a presentation from the California Department of Insurance staff to participate at your community outreach events.
- Establish a link to the www.mylowcostauto.com on your website.
- Allow the California Department of Insurance to provide information or an article on the California Low Cost Automobile Insurance Program for your newsletters.
- Distribute program materials at your center and community events.
