1. Is an employment provider from outside the USA able to bid on the basis that they will set up the appropriate format for registering as a corporation in California if successful in the bid?

Proposals will be accepted from all public agencies or private non-profit corporations. Applicants must clearly demonstrate their ability as defined in Section 2. Parts A, B and C. of the SFP.

2. Where may we find details of volumes of deaf people served per area in previous years for each site? Details of volumes of possible customers?

5. Is there a cost limit per area to be served, i.e., Sacramento region?
