SUBJECT: DOL VETS HVRP 2013

On May 15, 2013, the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) Veterans' Employment and Training Service (VETS) announced the availability of approximately \$5 million in Homeless Veterans Reintegration Program (HVRP) grant funds through a Solicitation for Grant Applications (SGA). The funds available under this SGA are focused on homeless female veterans and homeless veterans with families (HFVWWF) with grants awarded in two categories: Urban and Non-Urban geographical areas. The goal of these grants is to provide services to assist in reintegrating HFVWWF into meaningful employment within the labor force, and to stimulate the development of effective service delivery systems that will address the complex problems facing homeless female veterans and veterans with families. Successful applicants will propose programs that expedite the reintegration of eligible homeless veterans into the labor force.

The DOL anticipates awarding at least 16 grants. Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to state and local workforce investment boards, local public agencies, Native American tribal governments, Native American tribal organizations, for-profit/commercial entities, and non-profit organizations, including faith-based and community-based organizations.
