SUBJECT: VETERANS' EMPLOYMENT-RELATED ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
PY 2012/13 SFP AWARDS

On March 15, 2013, the Employment Development Department (EDD), in coordination with the California Workforce Investment Board and the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, announced the availability of up to \$4 million in Workforce Investment Act Governor's Discretionary 15 Percent funds (\$2 million) and 25 Percent Dislocated Worker Additional Assistance funds (\$2 million) through a Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program Solicitation for Proposals (SFP) process. The goal of this initiative is to promote the use of industry sector strategies as the framework for addressing the need for veterans to transition into high-wage, high-growth occupations using their skill sets obtained in the military.

In news release dated June 4, 2013, the EDD announced the awards totaling \$4 million and listed the 10 organizations selected through the SFP process to receive funds.
