The purpose of this Information Notice is to inform the workforce development community that the U.S. Department of Labor Job Corps program is seeking new applicants to fill 8,000 immediate openings nationwide.

The Job Corps is the nation's largest career technical training and education program for low-income individuals ages 16 through 24. It provides eligible students with an opportunity to receive:

- Career training at no cost;
- Hands-on experience with actual employers;
- A high school diploma or GED;
- Counselor and community leader mentoring;
- Assistance in finding a job or pursuing higher education; and
- Transitional support for up to 21 months after graduation.

Graduates train in skills needed to start a career, enlist in the military, earn a high school diploma, or pursue higher education.

Targeted states include, but are not limited to, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, Missouri, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, West Virginia, and Wisconsin.
