- Determines eligibility for DI benefits in accordance with laws, regulations, and policies.
- Interprets and applies laws, policies, and precedent to decisions consistently to individual cases.
- Performs a full range of disability claims examination work, including the investigation of the most difficult and complex cases with minimal supervision and a considerable degree of independence.

# Minimum Qualifications

**EITHER I:** Four years of experience with the Employment Development Department. (Candidates who are within six months of completing the required experience will be admitted to the examination; however, they must meet the required experience before being considered eligible for appointment.)

**OR II:** Completion of 60 semester units or 90 quarter units of college course work **and** two years of public contact experience providing services or information.

**OR III:** Equivalent to graduation from college. (Must provide evidence of registration as a senior in a recognized institution to be admitted in the examination, and must secure evidence of graduation or its equivalent before being considered for appointment.)
