- Ask a question about your claim.

#### **Information Needed to File a Claim:**

- » Social Security number
- » Name
- » Date of birth
- » Mailing address including ZIP Code
- » Residence address
- » Phone number
- » Driver license or state issued identification number
- **»** Last employer information (whether you worked full-time or part-time):
  - Employer name
  - Mailing address including ZIP Code
  - Phone number
  - Date last worked
  - Reason no longer working
  - Supervisor's name
- » Information on all employers you worked for in the last 18 months including:
  - Work outside California.
  - Worked for the federal government, have information from your Notice To Federal Employees About Unemployment Insurance, Standard Form 8.
  - Served in the military, have your DD214 Member Copy 4 available.
- » Alien Registration number and expiration date (if you are not a U.S. citizen or national).
