What is State Disability Insurance?

State Disability Insurance is a partial, short-term, wage-replacement insurance plan for California workers administered by the Employment Development Department (EDD) with two program components, Disability Insurance and Paid Family Leave.

Disability Insurance

Benefits paid if you are unable to work your regular or customary job due to your own illness, injury, or pregnancy.

Paid Family Leave

Benefits paid if you need time off work to care for a seriously ill family member, to bond with a new child, or to participate in a qualifying event because of a family member's military deployment to a foreign country. Paid Family Leave lets you be there for the Moments that Matter.
