## What is State Disability Insurance?

**State Disability Insurance** is a partial, short-term, wage-replacement insurance plan for California workers administered by the Employment Development Department (EDD) with two program components, Disability Insurance and Paid Family Leave.

**Disability Insurance** Benefits paid if your employee is unable to work their regular or customary job due to a non-work-related illness, injury, or pregnancy.

**Paid Family Leave** Benefits paid if your employee needs time off work to care for a seriously ill family member, bond with a new child, or assist their military family member with certain qualifying events.
