

Job Search and Training Services

State and local organizations work together to offer employment and job training services at no cost through America's Job Center of CaliforniaSM (AJCC) locations.

AJCC career counselors help job seekers identify interests, assess skills, and locate in-demand jobs and training.

AJCC Services:

- Access to education and job training opportunities that lead to new career pathways.
- Job search and resume assistance, job referral, placement assistance, and career coaching.
- Employment-related workshops and virtual job fairs.
- Career exploration tools and labor market information.
- Resource rooms that include computers with internet, telephones, and fax machines.
- Access to [CalJOBSSM](https://www.caljobs.ca.gov) (CalJOBS.ca.gov), California's online job resource with over a million job postings from more than 30,000 employers.
- Referrals to supportive services, including childcare, utility, housing, and transportation assistance.

Most AJCCs offer virtual, telephone, or in-person services. Service and hours vary, and are subject to change. Please call or email your local AJCC to confirm hours and availability before visiting.

NOTE: General assistance with applying for unemployment insurance (UI) benefits is available at most AJCCs. Assistance with resolving *existing* unemployment claims is not available at AJCCs.
