The EDD Data Library is an Online Application that improves the way we deliver non-confidential California labor market information to our clients, and furthers the Department's goal of providing our clients' with easy access to our quality data.

The new EDD Data Library is user-friendly and incorporates a responsive design that provides the same user-experience across multiple platforms. Additionally, it further enhances open access to our data by providing an extensive array of tools that allow users to interact with the datasets and create visualizations, custom datasets, filtered views, and dynamic connections via the API for real-time updates.

The EDD Data Library also makes it easier to take the data offline by providing more options for downloading datasets in multiple formats (e.g., csv, xls, xml, etc.), and allows data to be directly embedded onto other websites or linked to other applications.
