



CALIFORNIA EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

The California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC) is a tax credit created by Governor Jerry Brown and the Legislature to benefit California's working families and individuals. In 2017, the CalEITC provided almost \$200 million to 400,000 working Californians.
