

REGIONAL PLAN IMPLEMENTATION TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND EVALUATION RFA

The California Workforce Development Board (CWDB) and the Employment Development Department (EDD) are pleased to announce the availability of *Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act* funds to assess and evaluate the progress and impact of the CWDB's Regional Plan Implementation investments, and to provide training and technical assistance to the Regional Planning Units as they implement their regional plans.

Eligible applicants for this Request for Applications (RFA) include public and not-for-profit organizations, academic institutions, and private for-profit businesses that meet the minimum qualifications outlined in the RFA.

The CWDB and the EDD anticipate funding up to two grants. The total amount of funding is up to \$300,000 for Evaluation and up to \$350,000 for Technical Assistance. Grant periods will be 18 months for both grant opportunities.

All applications must be received no later than **March 18, 2019** at 3:00 p.m. PST.
