

## EVALUATION OF AJCCs – RFA

The California Workforce Development Board (CWDB) and the Employment Development Department (EDD) are pleased to announce the availability of up to \$750,000 in *Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act* (WIOA) funds to assess and evaluate the America’s Job Center of California<sup>SM</sup> (AJCC) system.

The AJCCs bring together local, state, private, and public entities to provide “one-stop” services to Californians in search of employment opportunities, work-related training, and education, while also serving as a resource to connect employers with qualified workers. WIOA significantly transformed the workforce system in California and, as a result, the performance of the AJCC system needs to be evaluated.

This Request for Applications (RFA) is intended for organizations with workforce program evaluation experience and may be suitable for research institutions, think tanks, and professional program evaluation organizations. The CWDB, the EDD, and the Labor and Workforce Development Agency are interested in a systematic evaluation of how local operational decisions, such as models of service provision, infrastructure investment, staffing, and local partnership shape access to services and labor market outcomes for program participants.

All applications must be received by 3 p.m. PT on **Monday, December 30, 2019**.
