

# Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program (VEAP) SFP PY 2017-18

## Questions and Answers

January 5, 2018

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- 1. Where can we find the Forms for the New VEAP 2017/18 Proposals? The links that are listed on the SFP are inactive and there are no forms on the EDD Website.**

The forms may be downloaded from the [Workforce Development Solicitations for Proposals](#) web page under the Veterans' Employment-Related Assistance Program SFP 2017-18 heading.

- 2. If we get one letter for both the Wagner-Peyser and the Local EDD JVSG program from the Deputy Division Chief, will this suffice or do we have to get two separate letters?**

One letter from the Deputy Division Chief with a wet signature will suffice for required "Partnership Agreement" from the Wagner-Peyser and JVSG program as stated in the SFP page 9 section 5 (A)(3).

- 3. Are the categories of "Female Veterans Ages 35-44" and "Female Veterans Ages 45-54" considered significant barriers to employment?**

The "Female Veterans Ages 35-44" and "Female Veterans Ages 45-54" are not considered barriers to employment. The VEAP 2017-18 seeks vertical progression for a diversified VEAP grant to help woman veterans' acquire employment opportunities.

- 4. Can you please clarify for me the funding source of the above SFP? Is it only from Gov. 15% Discretionary?**

The 2017-18 VEAP is solely 15% Governor's Discretionary funds and the allowable use of funds should be referred in the SFP page 6 section (1)(E).

- 5. The Information Notice issued November 30, 2017 has the proposal application due date stated as Wednesday, January 12, 2018, but the SFP page 7 states that proposals are due on Friday, January 12, 2018. Please confirm that the proposals are due on Friday, January 12, 2018.**

All proposals, whether mailed, delivered by courier service, or hand delivered, must be received by the EDD's WSB DDO on or before **Friday, January 12, 2018 3 p.m. PST**. The EDD's WSB DDO will accept hand and courier-delivered proposals between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. daily, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays, through Friday, January 12, 2018.

**6. Will supportive services be allowed during follow-up?**

Supportive Services are allowed in follow-up as long as the CalJOBS<sup>SM</sup> activity code does not interrupt a program exit.

**7. Our DOL-Approved Indirect Cost Rate (ICR) Agreement exceeds the 7.5% administrative rate, will it be disallowed?**

Organizations should refer to their DOL Negotiated Indirect Cost Agreement terms and specific treatment of “Administrative Costs” and any related limitations. When applying to the VEAP 2017-18 Grant please refer to the SFP Appendix B Administrative Costs for detailed definition of “Administrative Costs”. Organizations will have to adhere to the seven and a half percent administrative costs.
