## State Disability Insurance (SDI) Online

SDI Online is a fast and convenient way for Disability Insurance (DI) and Paid Family Leave (PFL) customers to submit claims and forms electronically. SDI Online provides many benefits such as:

- Access to DI claim status and payment history
- Reduction in paperwork and overhead
- Faster claim processing times
- Available in English and Spanish
- Immediate confirmation of claims filed and forms submitted

### Who can use SDI Online?

Claimants, employers, physicians/practitioners, physician/practitioner representatives, and voluntary plan (VP) administrators can use SDI Online to file DI and PFL claims and related forms.

### How can I sign up?

Please visit [www.edd.ca.gov/disability](http://www.edd.ca.gov/disability) to setup an account. You will need certain types of information to register based on your role:

Individual Claimants will need to provide:

- Legal name
- California Driver License or Identification Card number
- Valid email address
- Physical address
- Date of birth
- Mailing address (if different than physical address)
- Social Security number
- Valid phone number

Physician/practitioners, physician/practitioner representatives, and employers will need to provide **all of the information listed above** as well as the following:

Physician/Practitioners:

- Medical license type
- Medical license number

\*Physician/Practitioner Reps:

- Treatment address

\*\*Employers:

- State employee account number
- Registered ZIP code
- Total subject wages from the *Quarterly Contribution Return and Report of Wages*, DE 9C, submitted to the EDD

### Voluntary Plan

VP employers and third party administrators may register for an account by contacting a VP representative at 916-653-6839 or via email at [VPProgram@edd.ca.gov](mailto:VPProgram@edd.ca.gov).

\*Physician/practitioners will need to first set up an account then add you as an authorized representative.

\*\*Your business must be registered with the Employment Development Department (EDD) as an employer in the State of California.
